Before you tackle your list of spring projects, call 811, the nationwide on call system, or 800-DIG-RITE (800-344-7483), the Missouri One Call system and ask to have the underground utilities located.

This is a free service provided by Liberty Utilities and other local utilities. Simply call at least two full working days before you plan to dig.



The utilities will mark the location of underground facilities so you avoid them and stay safe.

This single call will allow you to avoid the possibility of a serious injury and the expense of repair costs for damaged utilities.
