The current service center in Baxter Springs, Kansas, 905 Ottawa Road, was built in the early 1960s. Crossland Construction is set to begin work on the new service center on July 9, 2018. The new building will accommodate for the length of new trucks, will meet all new code requirements, and will be more energy efficient. Additionally, the layout of the new structure will allow room for growth, storage, inperson customer service, and overall safer and more efficient operations.
